A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend the Rock Islands Management and Conservation Act, KSPL No. K8-207-2009, as amended by KSPL Nos. K8-209-2009, K9-226-2010, K9-242-2011, and K9-248-2011, to provide for new categories of Jellyfish Lake Permits for families and for extended or repeat visitors to Palau; to delete references to permit fees on required notices; and for related purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF KOROR REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF KOROR DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings.

The Tenth Koror State Legislature (the "Legislature") hereby finds that for many families who wish to visit Palau and to experience Jellyfish Lake and the Rock Islands, the purchase of a Jellyfish Lake Permit for each individual family member may be prohibitively expensive and may discourage families from visiting Palau. In addition, visitors who wish to experience Jellyfish Lake and the Rock Islands repeatedly over a 6-month time frame may also find the cost of purchasing multiple 10-day Permits excessively high. In order to encourage families and repeat visitors to travel to Palau, the Legislature finds that special categories of Jellyfish Lake Permits should be created for families and for extended or repeat visitors.

Section 2. Amendment of definition of "Valid Jellyfish Lake Permit" in Subsection 3(m) of KSPL No. K8-207-2009.

Subsection 3(m) of KSPL No. K8-207-2009 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(m) <u>Valid Jellyfish Lake Permit</u>. A Jellyfish Lake permit issued by Koror State that has originally been issued to one person in their name, <u>or to a family with the names of all covered family members listed on the permit</u>, which is paid in advance and which is not transferable."

Visitors who are six (6) years old and older. Additionally, a Jellyfish Lake Permit must be purchased for a fee of \$100.00 all Visitors who are six (6) years old and older. Individual Visitors may either purchase a Jellyfish Lake Permit that is valid for ten (10) consecutive days for a fee of \$100.00 or one that is valid for six (6) consecutive months for a fee of \$200.00. In addition, families visiting Palau may purchase a single Jellyfish Lake Permit, valid for ten (10) consecutive days, that covers all immediate members of a family (defined herein as a legally married couple and their children under the age of 21) for a fee of \$200.00. Permits are valid for ten (10) days and are not transferable. Permits shall be available for purchase from the Koror State Finance Office or designated agents.

If any person Visitor has purchased a Rock Island Use Permit for \$50.00 that does not include Jellyfish Lake and then that person Visitor decides he or she desires to visit Jellyfish Lake within the 10-day period of validity for such Rock Island Use Permit, such person Visitor shall pay an additional \$75.00 to visit Jellyfish Lake, in addition to paying the \$50.00 for the Rock Island Use Permit. The Tour Guide, Boat Operator or Tour Operator shall either pay the difference in permit cost to Koror State, or if the Tour Guide, Boat Operator, or Tour Operator arrives at Jellyfish Lake and announces the intent to change the scope of the Rock Island Use Permit for the Visitor tourist, then Koror State may issue a voucher charging the additional fee of \$75.00 to the Tour Guide, Boat Operator, or Tour Operator, and the tourist Visitor may access Jellyfish Lake. The Tour Guide, Boat Operator, or Tour Operator shall pay the \$75.00 difference to Koror State within forty-eight (48) hours. If such additional fee is not paid within such forty-eight hour period, then the Tour Guide, Boat Operator, and the Tour Operator shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall pay a fine of \$250.00 upon conviction for a first offense, and a fine
