

AN ACT

To amend KSPL No. K6-120-2001 to increase the compensation payable to members of the Koror State Public Lands Authority Board of Trustees and the members of the Koror Planning Commission on June 1, 2010, and for related purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF KOROR REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF KOROR DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1. Findings.** The Ninth Koror State Legislature hereby finds that the members
2 of the Koror State Public Lands Authority Board of Trustees and the members of the Koror
3 Planning Commission have been receiving \$35.00 for each meeting, as allowed by KSPL No. K8-
4 179-2006, and by KSPL No. K6-120-2001. Under Section 7 of KSPL No. K8-179-2006 (the
5 Unified Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2007), the KSPLA Board members and the Planning
6 Commission members have received \$35.00 for attendance at meetings; this increase was
7 intended to remain in effect "until amended by law." Compensation for the KSPLA and Planning
8 Commission members was also established at \$35.00 per meeting under KSPL No. K6-120-2001.
9 In order to attract and retain qualified and quality Board and Commission members, and due to
10 inflation and rising costs of living in Palau, the compensation payable "per meeting" should be
11 increased to be implemented this fiscal year after June 1, 2010 based on the availability of funds.
12 It is in the best interests of the people of the State of Koror to provide an increase in compensation
13 for attendance at meetings of the Koror State Public Lands Authority and the Koror Planning
14 Commission.

15 **Section 2. Amendment.** Section 1 (A) of KSPL No. K6-120-2001 is hereby amended
16 to read as follows:

17 "A. Each member of the Board of Trustees of the Koror State Public
18 Lands Authority and each member of the Koror Planning Commission shall be
19 entitled to receive the sum of \$50.00 for each day that a member actually attends
20 a meeting, unless such member is on administrative leave from the national or
21 state governments. Members otherwise employed by the national or state
22 governments shall only receive stipend for meetings to the extent that the meeting

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takes place before or after government business hours. This section shall take effect on June 1, 2010.”


Section 3. Severability. In the event that a court of competent jurisdiction determines that any part or portion of this Act is invalid or otherwise unenforceable, then the offending part or portion may be stricken, and the remaining portions shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall becoming effective upon its becoming law by operation of the Koror State Constitution.


