To amend Public Law No. K1-9-85 and for other purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF KOROR AS REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF KOROR DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. AMENDMENT.

Subsection 2 and 4 of Section 3 of Public Law No. K1-9-85 are hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. NOMINATIONS PETITIONS.

2. The petition, duly signed, shall be presented to the Koror State Registrar or his assistant, who shall verify the signatures of the petitioners and shall submit the petitions to the Koror State Commission

who within $\frac{24}{48}$ hours of receiving the petition, notify the candidate

either that the petition has been duly certified to the Koror State

Election Commission or that certification has been or denied by the Commission.

4. Petitions must be presented to the Koror State Registrar no later than 4:30 P.m., January 28, 1985 February 4, 1985.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the $\ensuremath{\mathsf{House}}$

of Traditional Leaders or upon its becoming law without such approval.
