FIRST OLBIIL ERA LLACH ER OREOR Koror State Public Law No. K1-10-85  
EIGHTH SPECIAL SESSION, February 1985 Bill No. 18

To amend Public Law No. K1-9-85 and for other purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF KOROR AS REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATURE OF  
THE STATE OF KOROR DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. AMENDMENT.

Subsection 2 and 4 of Section 3 of Public Law No. K1-9-85  
are hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. NOMINATIONS PETITIONS.

2. The petition, duly signed, shall be presented to the  
Koror State Registrar or his assistant, who shall verify the  
signatures of the petitioners and shall submit the petitions to  
the Koror State Commission  
who within ~~24~~ 48 hours of receiving the petition, notify the  
candidate  
either that the petition has been duly certified ~~to the Koror~~  
~~State~~  
~~Election Commission or that certification has been~~ or denied by  
the Commis-  
sion.

4. Petitions must be presented to the Koror State  
Registrar no later than 4:30 P.m., ~~January 28, 1985~~ February 4,  
1985.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval by  
the House  
of Traditional Leaders or upon its becoming law without such  
approval.
