FIRST KOROR STATE LEGISLATURE KOROR PUBLIC LAW NO. K1-23-87 NINETEENTH SPECIAL SESSION, DECEMBER 1987(Passed as Bill No. 67-87)

AN ACT

To authorize an extension for second quarter of fiscal year 1988 of FY86 Budget Act (K1-15-86) and funding of programs and activities until FY88 Budget and Appropriations Act is enacted.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF KOROR REPRESENTED IN THE KOROR STATE LEGISLATURE DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

- 1. The Koror State Budget Act, K1-15-86, for FY 1986 expired on September
- 30, 1986, but four subsequent Koror Public Laws extended its provisions and authorized and appropriated funding for each quarter of FY 1987 on the basis
- of 25% percent of that of fiscal year 1986. A similar Public Law was enacted

on September 30, 1987, to provide for the first quarter of FY 1988, and appropriated funds on the basis of 20% of the funds appropriated in FY 1986.

SECTION 2.

Koror State Government cannot carry out its responsibilities and operation in accordance with its Constitution and laws without enabling legislation authorizing expenditures after December 31, 1987.

SECTION 3.

The sum of twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriations of K1-15-86

is authorized to be appropriated and is appropriated, from all funds deposited into the Koror State Treasury, for obligations or expenditures for the budget activities and programs, that are contained in K1-15-86, for the second quarter of fiscal year 1988 (January 1, 1988 through March 31, 1988).

SECTION 4.

This Act shall take effect on January 1, 1988, upon its approval by the House of Traditional Leaders or upon its becoming law without such approval.
