A BILL FOR AN ACT

Requiring the State Executive Administrator to hire or contract an Auditor to audit Koror State Government.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF KOROR REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF KOROR DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. HIRING OF ACCOUNTANT TO AUDIT.

The State Executive Administrator is hereby empowered to contract or hire as soon as possible a certified public accountant to conduct, as soon as possible, after October 1, 1984, an inspection and audit of the revenues and expenditures of the Government of the State of Koror for the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 1983, and ending September 30, 1984.

SECTION 2. STATE AGENTS TO COOPERATE.

All employees, agents, officials, and representatives of all branches, commissions, and offices of the State of Koror shall furnish promptly to the auditor all documents which the auditor may request. If any such State person expects to be absent from work during the audit, he/she shall take steps so that the auditor can obtain during his absence any documents which may be under or in the custody or control of such person.

SECTION 3. AUDITOR TO FURNISH AUDIT REPORT TO STATE.

Within twenty days after completion of his work, the Auditor shall furnish a copy of the report to the State Executive Administrator, to the Koror State Legislature and to the House of Traditional Leaders.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the House of Traditional Leaders or upon becoming law without such approval.

Passed unanimously on the 8th day of August 1984 by the Legislature of the State of Koror.
