A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Koror Public Law No. K2-33-89 by reducing the size of registration numbers displayed on boats registered by the State of Koror.

THE PEOPLE OF KOROR REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF KOROR DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.

Section "6: A." of KPL No. K2-33-89 is hereby amended as follows:

"Such number shall consist of the letter "K" followed by not more than four digits; the letter "K" and the following digits shall appear together and each number shall be four inches (4") tall, and shall be two and one-half inches (2 and 1/2") wide, all on such appropriate sticker to be determined by the Administrator. Such numbers shall be affixed to the boat within eighteen inches (18") of the tip of the bow, and shall be within eight inches (8") of the gunwale of the boat, and shall be affixed on the starboard and port sides of the boat; it shall be easily visible to observers and shall not be obscured in anyway".

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY.

If a court of competent jurisdiction determines that any portion of this Act is null, or void, or unenforceable, then the remaining portions shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

The provisions of this Act shall become effective on January 01, 1994.
