AN ACT

To provide for a State of the State address by the Koror State Executive Administrator.

THE PEOPLE OF KOROR REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF KOROR DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Findings</u>. The Legislature finds it desirable and in the public interest for the State Executive Administrator, as the person best informed of the day to day operations of Koror State Government, to periodically present an address to apprise the House of Traditional Leaders and the Legislature of the past events and future plans of Koror State Government.

Section 2. State of the State Address. The third Friday of each January, commencing on January 19, 1996, the State Executive Administrator shall deliver a State of the State Address. The Address shall be an address to be given before the members of the Koror State Legislature and the members of the House of Traditional Leaders in front of the Koror State Office in Meketii Hamlet, or in another equally accessible and traditionally significant location such as Bai Ra Metal. The Address shall describe current State projects, State operations over the preceding twelve months, and State plans for the following year. The Address shall describe the State's financial situation and outlook, and detail the Executive Administrator's compliance with the budget law for the preceding twelve months.

Section 2. [SIC] <u>Effective Date</u>. This Act shall take effect upon approval of the House of Traditional Leaders or as otherwise provided by law.
