## AN ACT

To amend Section 5, B(1) of KSPL No. K5-82-97, relating to run-off election for Governor, and for related purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF KOROR REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF KOROR DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Amendment</u>. Section 5, B(1), of KSPL No. K5-82-97 is hereby amended to

as follows:

"(1) the two candidates who received the highest vote totals in the general election shall be voted upon in a "run-off" to be held on the second Tuesday of December immediately after the general election; voting in the run-off election shall be by secret ballot;"

. .

SECTION 2. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>. In the event that a court of competent jurisdiction determines that any pan or portion of this law is invalid, then the offending portion or portions may be stricken, and the remaining portions shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This Act shall become effective upon its becoming law by operation of the Koror State Constitution.
