#### AN ACT

To amend Koror State Public Law No. K7-146-2004 to provide for the exclusive use of certain rock islands by a television production company for a limited period of time, to establish penalties for violations of this Act, and for related purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF KOROR REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF KOROR DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1	SECTION 1. <u>PURPOSE</u> .	To grant SEG,	Inc.	(Survivor Er	ntertainment	Group,
2	Inc.)and Clearwater, Inc. an exem	nption from KSP	L No	. K6-113-200	00, Section 4,	during

- filming in Koror, and to amend KSPL No. K7-146-2004 to grant exclusive use rights to 3
- 4 them for a limited period of time.

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- 5 SECTION 2. FINDINGS. The Seventh Koror State Legislature hereby finds
- 6 that SEG, Inc. and/or Clearwater, Inc. ("Producers" as used in this Act) are
- 7 contemplating filming episodes of a popular television show in Palau in the fall of 2004.
- Producers need exclusive use rights in order to keep boats away from filming locations 8
- 9 so as to prevent disruption of filming and to preserve the integrity of filmed episodes,
- 10 and to insure privacy and secrecy of filmed activities.
- 11 SECTION 3. AMENDMENT OF KSPL NO. K7-146-2004; AREAS
- 12 PERMITTED TO BE USED EXCLUSIVELY DURING FILMING.
- 13 A. Section "3." of Koror State Public Law No. K7-146-2004 is hereby amended
- to read as follows: 14
- 15 "SECTION 3. AREAS PERMITTED TO BE USED DURING FILMING.
- 16 A. Producers and their employees, contractors, and agents, shall have the
- right to exclusively use, for filming and related purposes, the following beaches 17

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- and/or islands: 18
- 19 Any beach or island in Koror listed or not listed in

3	(2) The Governor shall provide written notice and shall			
4	publish such written notice in Tia Belau and Palau Horizon			
5	newspapers and other means of media before the exclusive use			
6	rights may be enforced.			
7	B. To the extent that this Act is inconsistent with or contradicts			
8	any other Koror State law, including but not limited to KSPL NO. K6-			
9	113-2000, the provisions of this Act shall prevail."			
10	SECTION 4. <u>DURATION OF EXCLUSIVE USE RIGHTS</u> . The exclusive use			
11	rights granted by this Act are made for Producers' benefit alone, and for the benefit of			
12	the employees, contractors, and agents of Producers, and such rights are not			
13	transferrable. Such exclusive use rights shall expire upon completion of filming in			
14	Palau, but no later than ten (10) months from the effective date of this Act. The			
15	Governor shall provide written notice of the termination of the exclusive rights granted			
16	by this Act, and shall cause such notice to be published in the Tia Belau and Palau			
17	Horizon newspapers and other means of media.			
18	SECTION 5. PENALTIES; ENFORCEMENT.			
19	A. Any person who enters into an exclusive use area as granted by this Act, as			
20	such exclusive use area is established by the Governor after publication of written			
21	notice as required by this Act, shall be provided with notice that the person is in an			
22	exclusive use right area, and that such person must leave the exclusive use right area. Any			
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23	person who remains in an exclusive use right area or otherwise refuses to leave the			
24	exclusive use right area after receiving warning or notice that they are in an exclusive use			

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- 1 right area, or any person who otherwise conducts themselves in such a way as to materially
- 2 interfere with the enjoyment of

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1	the exclusive use right without the authorization from Producers, or their employees,				
2	contractors, or agents, shall be in violation of this Act.				
3	B. Any person who violates the provisions of this Act shall. upon conviction, be				
4	fined in the amount of \$100.00, or shall be sentenced to spend up to thirty (30) days in jail				
5	(either full time or as "work release"), or both.				
6 7	SECTION 6. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE.</u> This Act shall become effective upon its becoming law by operation of the Koror State Constitution.
