



1 exercises the sovereign functions of the State of Koror on behalf of the Administration of Koror  
2 State Government, or whose duties are set forth in laws or Executive Orders of the State of  
3 Koror.

4 (B) “public employment” means being employed by the Administration of Koror State  
5 Government, and includes being an employee of the Koror State Public Lands Authority, the  
6 Koror State Planning Commission, and any other agency, board, commission, or authority of the  
7 State of Koror, or holding any other employment with the State of Koror as the employer.

8 **Section 3. Prohibition; penalties.**

9 (A) No person may hold any other public office or public employment while serving as a  
10 member of the Koror State Legislature. Before a person is sworn-in as a member of the  
11 Legislature, he or she shall resign from any public office or public employment before the  
12 swearing-in date.

13 (B) If a person is elected to the Legislature, and holds any public office or public employment  
14 as of the time of swearing-in as a member of the Legislature, then that person shall be deemed to  
15 have voluntarily resigned from such public office or public employment as of the time of being  
16 sworn-in as a member of the Legislature.

17 (C) Any person who exercises the duties of public office or public employment in  
18 violation of this Act shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall pay a fine in  
19 the amount of \$100.00, and shall be sentenced to jail for a period of up to thirty (30) days in jail,  
20 for each day that this Act is violated. For any subsequent offenses, the jail time shall be  
21 increased over any previous jail sentence imposed. Each day that this Act is violated shall  
22 constitute separate offenses which may be punished separately.

23 **Section 4. Severability.** In the event that a court of competent jurisdiction determines  
24 that any part or parts of this law is invalid, then the offending part or parts may be stricken, and  
25 the remaining portions shall continue in full force and effect.

26 **Section 5. Effective date.** This Act shall become effective upon its becoming law by  
27 operation of the Koror State Constitution.
