MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 18-61

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT OF LANDS  
FRONTING ON PUBLIC ROADS.

ARTICLE I

WHEREAS the Koror Municipal Council deems it in the best interest of the community to maintain the municipality in a clean condition at all times,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council that all land owners and lessees of Government lands fronting on aLL public roads in the Municipality of Koror, including the roads in Ngeremid, Ngerkesouaol, Ngerchemai; Iebukel, T-Dock Road from the dock to the main intersection; Ngerbeched, Miuns, Malakal; the main Highway from the Skogi ramp in Ngarkebesang through to the Sansaro at Topside; the two secondary roads, and any public roads connecting any of the above mentioned roads, shall be required to maintain these lands in a clean condition at all times, disposing of scrap and trash, keeping woods cut, filling holes and otherwise maintain good landscaping practices (such maintenance and improvement to cover no less than fifty feet away from the side of the road,)

ARTICLE II

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the District Senior Sanitarian with the Municipal Council is hereby requested to inspect these lands from time to time to determine whether the provisions and intent of this ordinance are being fulfilled and notify the magistrate of any violations.

ARTICLE III

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any person violating the provisions of Article I of this Ordinance shall be penalized in the following manner: the Municipality receives the right to hire labor to do this maintenance and improvement work and charge the costs to them if the land owners and lessees of Government lands fail to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance.
