MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 15-1960

AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1960 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1961, AND REVOKING AND SUPERSEDING ALL PREVIOUS ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE APPROPRIATION, EXPENDITURES AND AMENDMENTS THERETO.

WHEREAS Article VII of the Charter of the Municipality of Koror provides the power to make budget and the collection, disbursement and care of funds by ordinance, and

WHEREAS Municipal Ordinance No. 14-1960, in accordance with Article VI of the Charter, provides assessment and collection of taxes, license fees, and other fees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Koror, that the aggregate sum of twelve thousand four hundred and thirty dollars and ninety cents (\$12,430.90), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from current revenue together with any cash balance at the end of Fiscal Year 1960 for expenditures by Municipality of Koror for the purposes hereinafter stated and subject to conditions hereinafter set forth, during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1960 and ending June 30, 1961:

Section 1. The sum of \$3,024.00 shall be set aside for administrative salaries to be paid as follows:

- a. Magistrate (@\$100.00 per month) \$1,200.00 per annum.
- b. Clerk-treasurer (@\$ 60.00 per month) \$720.00 per annum.
- c. Census clerk (@\$ 32.00 per month) \$384.00 per annum.
- d. Tax collector (@\$ 45.00 per month) \$540.00 per annum.
- e. Janitor-yardman (@\$ 15.00 per month) \$180.00 per annum.

Section 2. The sum of \$730.50 shall be set aside for unpaid administrative salaries and honorarium for the councilmen to be paid as follows:

- a. Magistrate..... \$450.00
- b. Councilmen..... \$280.50

Section 3. The sum of \$1,188.00 shall be set aside for the honorarium of chief, hamlet chiefs, councilmen and congressmen to be paid as follows:

- a. High Chief (@\$5.00 per month) \$ 60.00 per annum
- b. Hamlet chiefs (@\$5.00 per person \$480.00 per annum  
per month)
- c. Councilmen (@\$1.50 per person \$378.00 per annum  
per month)

- d. Congressmen (@\$30.00 per person \$270.00 per annum per month)

Section 4. The sum of \$480.00 shall be set aside for Scout Fund to be used for development of youngsters' activities.

Section 5. The sum of \$30.00 shall be set aside for the purchases of administration stationery and office supplies.

Section 6. The sum of \$240.00 shall be set aside for the purchases of office equipment.

Section 7. The sum of \$300.00 shall be set aside for the rental of vehicles and boats for use on official business.

Section 8. The sum of \$50.00 shall be set aside for the municipal election expense.

Section 9. The sum of \$812.10 shall be set aside for the painting and other final works to the new office building and landscaping on surrounding area.

Section 10. The sum of \$3,969.62 shall be set aside for repayment on Trust Territory Government loan.

Section 11. The sum of \$375.00 shall be set aside for the payment of [INDISCERNIBLE] municipal office building [INDISCERNIBLE] expenses.

Section 12. The sum of \$200.00 shall be set aside for the roads improvement reserve fund.

Section 13. The sum of \$1,071.68 shall be set aside for the Koror Elementary school general improvement fund.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that all previous appropriation and expenditures ordinances and amendments thereto of the Municipality of Koror in conflict with the provisions contained herein are hereby revoked and superseded by this ordinance.

PASSED BY two-third (2/3) majority affirmative vote of the Municipal Council of Koror, on July 25, 1960.
