MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 19A-61

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND TAGGING OF DOGS

WHEREAS the population of Koror Municipality is rapidly increasing,
making good sanitation a difficult problem, and

WHEREAS the Municipal Council deems it in the best interest of good
sanitary practice to eliminate stray and wild dogs from the island;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that all dogs two months of age or older shall be required to have tags, which tags shall be issued together with a license, to the owner by the municipality upon payment of a \$1.00 dog tax to the municipal treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all dogs two months of age or older not carrying tags shall be properly disposed of.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this ordinance shall become effective upon being approved by the District Administrator.
