MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 20-61

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE MANUFACTURE AND CONSUMPTION OF
LOCALLY MANUFACTURED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

WHEREAS Article III of Resolution No. 80-61, Fall Session, of
the Olbiil
era Kelulau authorized each municipality in the Palau District
to hold a Popular Referendum to determine whether the
importation and sale of Alco- holic Beverages shall be
permitted; and

WHEREAS the municipality of Koror did on this 9th day of
November, 1961,
hold such a referendum and voted against the manufacture of
local bev-
erages for the personal consumption of the manufacturer or his
guests;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to manufacture,
possess or
consume or import any locally-manufactured alcoholic
beverages
within the boundaries of Koror Municipality; further
2. That the Magistrate or his duly authorized
representative(s) shall
be authorized to confiscate or order to be confiscated, by
force
if necessary, any facilities or equipment used for the
manufacture
of local beverages; and further
3. That whosoever shall unlawfully manufacture, possess or
consume locally-manufactured alcoholic beverages shall be
guilty of a mis-
demeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be imprisoned
for a
period of not more than thirty (30) days, or shall be fined
not

more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) or both.

PASSED by a two-third (2/3) majority vote of the Municipal Council on this 4th day of December, 1961.
