MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 50-1969

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PERMIT REQUIREMENT AND FEE FOR  
PROFESSIONAL  
PHOTOGRAPHERS TAKING PICTURES OR MOVIES IN KOROR MUNICIPALITY  
FOR  
COMMERCIAL PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF KOROR:

Section 1. Commercial Photographers Permit. No  
Professional  
photographer who is not a permanent resident of Koror  
Municipality  
shall take pictures or movies in Koror Municipality for  
commercial  
purposes unless he first obtains a permit to do so from the  
Mayor  
or his designated representative. The fee for such permit shall  
be  
fifty dollars (\$50.00) per month and shall be paid to the Koror  
Municipal Treasurer in advance of the issuance of the permit,  
and may  
be disbursed by him for public interest in accordance with law.  
Whosoever violates the provisions of this section shall be  
guilty  
of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined  
not more  
than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), or imprisoned for not more  
than  
one month, or both.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon the  
approval  
of the District Administrator or upon its becoming law without  
such  
approval.
